



Symbols & Sketching

Often in our PD (psychic development) process – we see symbols clairvoyantly. It is important for our depth of understanding - to be able to remember the quality of the symbol and to sketch it for ourselves. No need to get self-conscious here – your sketching abilities are not and will not be called into question. Not allowing your insecurities or ego to keep you from sketching what you see is important.

Clairvoyance is the most symbolic & metaphoric of our psychic skills. It is also - through spirit's use of symbols - the psychic skill that seems to come most directly from our subconscious aspects of our mind. Since so much is stored there - including pre-verbal and perhaps non-verbal lifetimes of information - it often comes through in pictures and symbols.

Approach: Sketch the symbol for your own capture and use of it, in your Intuition Journal. Turn to the symbol and ask it or spirit if it has further information for you. Pay attention (through all of your psychic pathways) to what comes forward for you. Does it feel

Celtic? Ancient? Does it have inviting or a repulsive type energy for you? Etc.
